



THE FULBRIGHT ARTISTS TALKS SERIES November 1 and 2, 2016, 6-8 p.m. at Circuits & Currents-Project Space of the Athens School of Fine Arts

The Fulbright Foundation in Greece, in collaboration with the Careers Office of the Athens School of Fine Arts, invites alumni from the Fulbright Artists Programs to Circuits & Currents-Project Space of the Athens School of Fine Arts (Notara 13 & Tositsa Streets), for a short presentation of their work and a roundtable discussion on their U.S. experience as a Fulbright grantee.
