Adaptive Reuse: cultural heritage towards a new sustainable future

Organised by: InHeriT ERASMUS+, KEPPEDIH-KAM, TU Crete Architecture School Light Structures Lab

In the context of the above title, what is proposed is a week dedicated to cultural (built and intangible) heritage in the light of its inherent potential for a new creative and sustainable future. The whole of InHeriT's activity is publicly presented for the first time in collaboration with relative activities from other stakeholders, such as the University of Ioannina Architecture Department and with the participation of the architectural community of Greece and Cyprus.

The week activities aim at:

1. The public presentation and wide dissemination of InHeriT's work.
2. Communication with other relative stakeholders and possible future partners.
3. Communication with young creative professionals and students (as a special target group).
4. The promotion of InHeriT's basic concepts to the wider public.
5. Discussing InHeriT's future sustainability.

The list of parallel activities includes:

A. Projects Exhibition in partnership with the architecture schools of Greece, Cyprus and Italy: 29 May - 4 June 2018 with the support of the University of Ioannina.

The University of Ioannina Department of Architecture plans to include InHeriT's agenda in its spring semester. A specific historical location (such as the Chania Venetian Arsenal) will be addressed in the context of adaptive renewal both programmatically and in various spatial scales. The proposals will be also presented in the exhibition.

B. 3rd InHeriT Local Seminar: 29 May -2 June 2018 [organised by TUC–InHeriT & KEPPEDIH-KAM]. The Seminar will this time be open to public participation in order to further disseminate its ideas and content. Participants representing local stakeholders, including the local regional and municipal authorities, the ephorate of antiquities, the chamber of commerce and industry, the chamber of

tourism as well as local NGO's and small enterprises and community groups will be following the Seminar on an everyday basis in order to further promote InHeriT's basic concepts as well as to discuss in more detail their own experiences and concerns.

C. InHeriT Intensive Conference Day: 3rd & 4th June 2018 [organised by TUC-InHeriT, KEPPEDIH-KAM & Uoi Dept. of Architecture]

The conference has a double structure:

The Morning Session contains presentations of the exhibition projects with the participation of academics and students from participating schools.

The Afternoon Session contains round table discussions aiming at assessing and contextualising InHeriT's intellectual outputs. Participants will include, apart from presenting InHeriT team members, representatives from the cultural heritage community of stakeholders (mixed panels of architects, archaeologists, economists, policy makers, researchers, entrepreneurs, administration, NGO's and cultural institutions and initiatives). The final target is to review the possibilities for future policy making strategies.

The round tables will reflect InHeriT's intellectual outputs structure and content, namely:

1. Cultural Heritage and Sustainable Development: Economic Benefits, Social Opportunities and Policy Challenges [01]
2. Mapping the Cultural Districts of Chania, Messinia and Paphos: social, environmental and physical space parameters. [04]
3. Developing Educational Material for the Promotion of a New Agenda for Cultural Heritage Sustainability: issues of structure and content (bridging the gap, building a new common topos) [05 & 06]
4. InHeriT and its future sustainability: What comes next?
