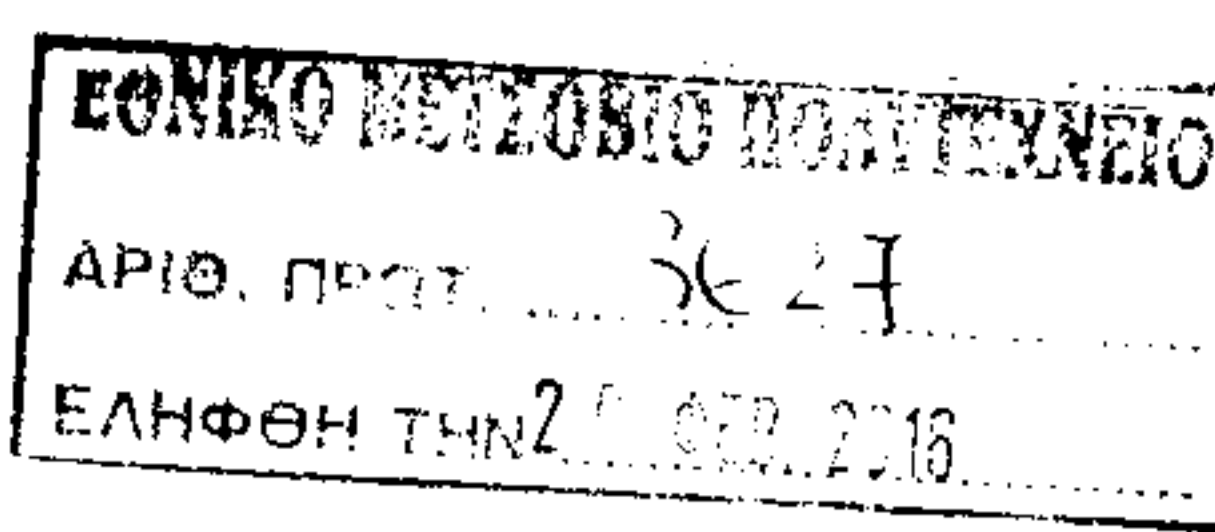

What is the National Scholarship Programme?

- The National Scholarship Programme for the Support of Mobility of Students, PhD students, university teachers, researchers and artists as a scholarship programme approved by the Government of the Slovak Republic in 2016.
- The National Scholarship Programme of the Slovak Republic organizes study and research grants at universities and research organizations. It supports mobility — of foreign scholarship holders to Slovakia as well as of Slovak scholarship holders abroad.
- The Programme scholarship holders are scholarship holders in the Government of the Slovak Republic. The National Scholarship Programme is financed by the Ministry of Education, Science, Research and Sport of the Slovak Republic and administered by SAI A, n. o.

SAIA, n. o.

- SAI A, n. o. (Slovak Academic Information Agency) is a non-governmental nonprofit organizational centre established in 1992. It has been providing legal services and grant services aimed at strengthening of civil society and assisting to internationalisation of education and research in Slovakia. SAI A provides information and advisory services related to study and research mobility, administrative, visa and scholarship and grant programmes and promotes Slovak universities and research organisations abroad.

Foreign Applicants for Scholarship Stays in Slovakia

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
 - related to a study stay (1 – 2 semesters) of foreign university students at a Slovak university during their Master studies
 - related to a study/research stay (1 – 2 months) of PhD students from foreign universities/research organisations at a university or research organisation eligible to carry out PhD study or research in Slovakia during their PhD studies
 - related to a teaching/research or artistic stay (1 – 12 months) of university teachers, researchers or artists from foreign universities/research organisations at a university/research organisation eligible to carry out PhD study programme or to governmentally organisation in Slovakia

Individuals with permanent residence in Slovakia and citizens of the Slovak Republic studying or working at universities or research orgs. statuses abroad have to apply for the Programme scholarship for foreign applicants.

Citizens of which countries are eligible?

Citizens of the following countries will apply for the scholarship:

- a) the Member States of the European Union
- b) other countries participating in the Bologna Process: Albania, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Iceland, Kazakhstan, Liechtenstein, Republic of Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Russian Federation, Serbia (including Kosovo), Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine, Yukatan City



- a) Uzbekistan
- b) Canada, Mexico, USA countries of Latin America (Cuba, Jamaica, Haiti, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Chile, Argentina, Paraguay, Uruguay, Ecuador, Venezuela, Peru, Bolivia, Colombia, Venezuela, Cuba, Honduras, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Guatemala, Belize, Panama, Republic of Korea, New Zealand, Kyrgyzstan, Sri Lanka, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam

What is the amount of a scholarship?

- a) university student of second level of higher education 550 €
- b) PhD student 580 €
- c) university teacher, researcher or artist
 - without PhD degree and less than 4 years of work experience 550 €
 - with PhD degree and less than 10 years of work experience 650 €
 - with PhD degree and more than 10 years of work experience 1 000 €

The amount of a scholarship shall cover average living costs of a scholarship holder.

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply online at www.scholarships.sk. System opens not later than 6 weeks before the deadline. After submitting online application for a stay with all attachments, applicant shall send original hard copy of hard application invitation letter to SAA Bratislava not later than on the day of the application deadline. Information on application forms, required documents and sending/submitting the required documents can be found at the Programme website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- 30 April by 16:00 CET – Scholarship stays for the next academic year
- 31 October by 16:00 CET – Scholarship stays for the summer semester of the coming academic year

Slovak Applicants for Scholarship Stays and Travel Grants Abroad

What is offered?

- **scholarships covering living costs**
 - related to a study stay abroad (1 – 2 semesters) of 1 – 5 beneficiaries of Slovak university students of regular Master studies
 - related to a study/research stay abroad (1 – 12 months) of PhD students at the Slovak universities or research organisations eligible to carry out PhD study programme at the Slovak Academy of Sciences during their PhD studies

- **travel grants** – covering travel costs related to study or research stays abroad of students of Slovak universities during their Master studies, full-time PhD students of Slovak universities during their PhD studies and university teachers, researchers or artists from Slovak universities and the Slovak Academy of Sciences

Which country can you choose for your scholarship stay?

The Programme considers only non-EU country invited. After being awarded a scholarship, you can carry out your scholarship stay in a country of the world.

What is the amount of a scholarship?

The amount of a scholarship is set for every country individually. It shall cover average living costs during scholarship stay. When setting the amount of a scholarship, just living costs are taken into consideration. It does not cover other costs (e.g. tuition fee).

At www.stipendia.sk 31 of countries can be found to which scholarships have already been granted.

What is the amount of a travel grant?

Travel grant is a contribution related to travel costs to and from a scholarship stay. Scholars' stay shall last at least one month. In the case of students at least one academic quarter (semester/trimester). Special or distinctive awards: the amount of a travel grant (setting into consideration up-to-date prices of transportation and lodging at destination of the Programme).

How to apply?

Applicants shall apply online at www.stipendia.sk. System opens not later than 6 weeks before the deadline. After submitting online application form with all attachments, applicant shall send original or signed hard copy of application form to SAA Bratislava not later than on the day of the application deadline. Information on application forms, required documents and sending/submitting the required documents can be found at the Programme website.

What are the deadlines for submitting application forms?

- 30 April by 16:00 CET – Scholarship stays for the next academic year
- 31 October by 16:00 CET – Scholarship stays for the summer semester of the coming academic year
