## **Dean's Distinguished Scholarships**

for Doctoral studies

The Cyprus Institute (CyI) announces prestigious new scholarships for doctoral studies. The *Dean's Distinguished Scholarships* for PhD studies provide full support to eligible young scholars able to demonstrate outstanding academic performance and potential to pursue doctoral research enrolled in the Institute's world-class doctoral programs.

During the 2016-2017 academic terms, the Institute will offer three scholarships, one in each of doctoral programs:

- Energy, Environment and Atmospheric Sciences
- Computational Sciences
- Science and Technology in Cultural Heritage.

Successful candidates will receive financial support for up to three (3) years that is the minimum duration of the PhD studies, at the CyI:

- Full funding of registration, tuition and bench fees (16,400 Euro per annum)
- A stipend of 14,000 EURO per annum for living expenses
- Travel and relocation expenses from their country of origin

We look forward to welcoming applications from candidates of outstanding potential. This scholarship scheme will offer prospective candidates the opportunity to work with distinguished faculty, get trained in the use of cutting edge methods and techniques, have access to state-of-the-art infrastructure and carry out research within internationally recognized research teams in their chosen field. In certain cases, PhD studies could be jointly pursued with internationally recognized institutions with which Cyl maintains agreements for dual degrees.
