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**Kostas Daflos** (1971) lives in Athens. Explores since 2003 through the *Cipo\_* program methods between art and architecture based on interactive technological pieces. He creates *do-it-yourself* (DIY) vehicles and art installations for his dialogical public nomadic performances which intervene the urban terrain as live participative acts. The *CIP0\_program* (means cybernetic intelligent parasitic object) is an ongoing research which explores the social dimension of places in different conditions (e.g. economic, refugee or pandemic crisis). Since 2002 he has participated in several international open call independent festivals in different interdisciplinary art and technology frameworks, e.g.: 4th LAST Festival: *Life /Art /Science /Technology*, San Jose State University (California), 3rd & 2nd *Diffrazioni Festival* (Florence, 2019, 2016), *Fornos\_Center for Digital Culture* (Athens), *Bios ‘Opa!’* (Athens), *TeDance ‘Technologically Expanded Dance’* (Lisbon), *Break 2.3 ‘New Species’* (Ljubljana), Digital art exhibition *‘Science & Art’* (Shanghai), Museum of Contemporary Art (Rethymnon, Crete, 2019). Preselected in: *Body>data>space: Robots + Avatars* (2012), 3rd LAST Festival, Interactive Digital Experimental Art (IDEA), Stanford University (California).

He has organized, coordinated and participated in several intensive workshops, collaborative public researches exploring the collective dimension of social experience, with educational and critical content, in the cross field of art and architecture. His interests focus on the literal and poetic sides of

*dialogical art, social engaged art, tactical media and activism* related to the theory of *cyborg, performativity, the everyday life, common public spheres* (XXII UIA World Congress, Istanbul, 2005 etc.). His artistic and editorial activity (publications: Futura 2005, Papatirou 2007, Alexandria 2011) includes critics, several essays and writings for conferences, or as a reviewer for Program & Scientific Committees, e.g.: IET - International Conference on Intelligent Environments (IE'06, IE'07, IE'09, IE'10, IE'11, IE'14, IE'15, IE'16, IE'17, IE'19), Hybrid City III, etc. His recent published authorial academic activity (in Greek) are: "*Tactics of Techno-political Media: an approach for common places-dispositions*", Athens: Hellenic Academic eBooks (2016), (paperback) NTUA University Press (2017), & "*Performative Art Practices: an approach for common places -active subjects*", Athens: Hellenic Academic eBooks (2016), (paperback) NTUA University Press (2017).

At parallel, since 2000 he has implemented several realized architectural works and studies as cofounder of [pan.da] architects; focuses on the microclimatic, sustainable design in architecture, upcycling methods and systems. Presents works in many exhibitions.
